Upon the motion offered by Commissioner Walthall-Moon and seconded by Commissioner Yizar that Public Hearing on the 2022 Budget of the Fairview Fire District shall be called to order at 18:00:

Chair Malone read the following notice,

The purpose of this public hearing is to allow members of the public to make comment on the 2022 proposed budget. Please note that it is only a proposed budget until the Board of Fire Commissioners adopts the final budget.

The Notice of Budget Hearing was published in the Journal News on October 14, 2021, and it was posted on the Fire District website and signboard from September 30, 2021, through October 19, 2021. The notices specified the time, date, and place where this public hearing would be held.

A copy of the notice of Budget Hearing was submitted to the Town Clerk of the Town of Greenburgh for posting on the Town website and signboard from October 4, 2021, through October 19, 2021.

A copy of the proposed budget was posted on the Fire District website and was available for inspection in the Office of the Fire District Secretary and the Office of the Town Clerk.

Chair Malone presented the proposed budget of the Fairview Fire District for the year 2022.

Chair Malone stated that the public comments period now begins. He asked that anyone wishing to speak clearly state their name for the record and limit their comments to five (5) minutes.

There were three (3) members of the public present.

The public comments period was concluded at 18:07

The Chair announced that the final budget for the year 2022 would be adopted at the special meeting immediately following this budget hearing.


