House & Grounds Committee

The Committee met on 29 March 2021.

Commissioner Walthall-Moon reported that the committee visited Station 2, going over exterior issues, and identifying tripping hazards. They worked on listing and prioritizing what needs to be addressed at both Headquarters and Station 2. Commissioner Walthall-Moon stated that she is currently working on the updates for the Headquarter's Board room.

Chief Reiss reported that FF LoGuidice is almost done converting Headquarter's lighting to LED lights.

Finance Committee

The Committee met on 5 April and 8 April 2021, and completed all of the 2020 bank reconciliations, and is in the process of completing payroll.



Chief's Report

R21-04-04

Upon the motion offered by Commissioner Yizar and seconded by Commissioner Walthall-Moon that the Board shall approve Chief Howard Reiss and Captain Timothy Ryan to attend NYS Weekend at the National Fire Academy in Emmetsburg, MA, from 27 August 2021 to 29 August 2021 at the cost of \$55.30 per person: Commissioners Simmons, Yizar, Walthall-Moon, Robinson, and Malone voting aye, nays none, none absent. The motion was carried.

The second certiorari for 2021 has been received for Crossroads Joint Venture for \$60,530.79

Spring Training Days will be in May and early June. Members will be training on the Con Edison simulator at the Westchester Country Fire Training Center.

Chief Reiss reported two Line of Duty Deaths. Watertown Firefighter Recruit Peyton Morse experienced a medical emergency during a training evolution on 3 March 2021 at the NYS Fire Academy at Montour Falls. He passed away on 12 March 2021. On behalf of the District, Chief Reiss reached out to Chief Timmerman to offer our condolences and support. Spring Valley Volunteer Firefighter Jared Lloyd died fighting an active fire at the Evergreen Court Adult Home in Spring Valley on 23 March 2021. Firefighter Lloyd rushed in to rescue residents trapped inside. Several members attended the Funeral Service, and Chief Reiss reached out to the Chief of Spring Valley to offer condolences and support.

The Department of Health has issued new guidance regarding COVID-19 quarantines. Chief Reiss explained the travel and exposure requirements for vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals. There are no quarantine requirements for domestic travel as long as an individual remains asymptomatic. A vaccinated or recently positive person does not have to quarantine after exposure to COVID-19 as long as they remain asymptomatic.

FF Michael Murray was able to partner with the American Red Cross, 'Sound the Alarm' program, to provide free smoke detector installation for residents of the fire district.

Annual Department Physicals at Partners in Safety in White Plains are complete for career staff. We are beginning the process of scheduling physicals for the volunteer members.

On 21 March, the Department responded to a dual response Motor Vehicle Accident with severe injuries that required extrication on the Sprain Brook Parkway with Elmsford Fire Department. Deputy Chief Sydney Henry of Elmsford sent Chief Reiss a thank you letter, praising the actions of our members on the call, namely Capt. Jimmy Malone Jr and Firefighters Scaperrotta and PJ Murray.

Chief Reiss reported that the Secretary received a FOIL request from a Hartsdale resident, Mona Fraitag, request actual annual expenditures for the years 2000 through 2020.

The Department responded to 184 alarms in March 2021, including 98 EMS and Extrication calls, 7 mutual aid-out responses, and 9 mutual aid-in responses.
